Museu de Arte de São Paulo Assis Chateaubriand Appoints Adjunct Curator of Fashion

Hanayrá Negreiros has been named adjunct curator of fashion at the Museu de Arte de São Paulo Assis Chateaubriand, where she will lead MASP Renner, a project that brings together artists and fashion designers in Brazil to create clothes for the institution's collection. Negreiros specializes in African and Afro-diasporic art and aesthetics as they relate to modes of dressing. Adriano Pedrosa, artistic director of MASP, said in a statement, "Negreiros is an extraordinary thinker with a keen interest on Black culture, connecting art and fashion in a unique and novel way."
